**PUBLIC HEALTH PRACTICE AND PROGRAM MANAGEMENT:** Specialization in this area encompasses many identifiable public health programs and activities such as maternal and child health, aging, mental health, environmental health, and professional disciplines such as medicine, dentistry, nursing, and social work. **Salary range within one year of graduation \$41,175 - \$102,000.**

**NUTRITION:** In short supply in the public and private sectors, these specialists are concerned with the study of the interaction between nutrients,

and health and the application of sound nutritional principles to maintain good health. **Salary range within one year of graduation, \$31,500 - \$70,875.**
